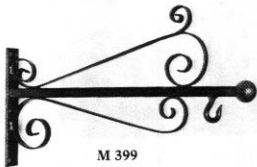


LAMPS AND LANTERNS

All lamps and lanterns are fitted at the foundry with British-type bayonet-contact bulb sockets. While we stock British light bulbs and can supply them on request, we normally convert the lamps to receive American light bulbs by installing a UL-approved bulb socket at a nominal charge. The conversion can also easily be done by an electrician or lamp store. Specify "converted", if desired.

May be used with standard junction box.



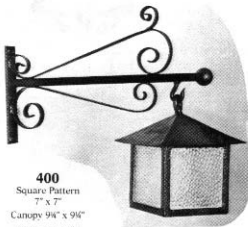

Rigidly constructed of 3/4" x 3/4" heavy square tubing, flare-forged and welded to 3/16" mounting plate and ending in a solid 1 3/4" diameter sphere. The curved straps are welded to the mounting plate and square tubing for additional strength and ornamentation.

Electrical wire (not supplied) enters through mounting plate into square tubing and exits through a hole in bottom and behind the hook. The M 399 Bracket can be used for many other lanterns, baskets, signs, and in similar applications.

The 400 and 401 lanterns can be hung from the M 399 or similar bracket or suspended by chain from an overhang or a ceiling. Electrical wire (not supplied) enters through a hole at the base of the hook on top of the canopy.
